Friendly Reminders



Automotive Maintenance and Policies: Due to environmental and safety concerns, automobile/vehicle maintenance shall not be performed by Resident, Occupant or Guest anywhere in the Neighborhood or Premises including garages, carports, parking spaces, or street. This includes but is not limited to repairs, engine cleaning, oil changing, and car washing.

Outdoor grills are permitted only outside the home no closer than ten (10) feet to the house or fence. Barbecue grills should not be left unattended when in use or while still hot. Cooking food in the front yard or on covered balconies, and/or patios using hibachis, grills, etc. is

Prohibited. Fire Pits, including free standing fire pits, Tiki Torches or like items are not permitted.



Children Playing Outdoors:

With the temperatures warming up, children will start playing outside more often. We just want to remind you to take a little extra time to be aware of your surroundings. Be sure to look both ways at intersections. Make sure to slow down in neighborhoods, and keep an eye out for children playing in the streets.



Pools: NO swimming pools or hot tubs are allowed on property. Wading pools are allowed and must be emptied and put away daily. Wading pools are only allowed in the backyard.
